This update fixes the following issues:

- When you tab through the **Create** or **Edit** form for calendar lists, the text box for filling in a custom category can't be focused on after you tab out of it.
- If you delete an attached file of a list item and try to upload a file that has the same name, you receive the "A file with the name already exists" error message.
- When you press Alt+F7 by using JAWS to open the link list to see all links in a document library, each document in the library has an "Open Menu" link to open the Edit Control Block (ECB) menu, and you cannot determine which document each link belongs to.
- When you try to paste multiple lines of text from Excel to a multiline text field by using a datasheet view in Internet Explorer, you receive the following error message:

The format of the clipboard data isn't recognized.

This update fixes the following issue:

When you press Alt + F7 by using JAWS to open the Link List to see all links in a document library, each document in the library has an "Open Menu" link to open the Edit Control Block (ECB) menu, and you cannot determine which document each link belongs to.

This update fixes the following issue:

After an incremental profile synchronization, all mapped property values are lost if there's an exception in WCF that supplements user profiles.

This update fixes the following issue:

Macros aren't preserved when you convert a .docm file to a .doc file by using Word Automation Services.

Description of the security update for SharePoint Server 2013: July 11, 2017 (KB3213559)

This security update resolves vulnerabilities in Microsoft Office that could allow remote code execution if a user opens a specially crafted Office file. To learn more about these vulnerabilities, see [Microsoft Common Vulnerabilities and Exposures CVE-2017-8501](#).

Note To apply this security update, you must have the release version of [Service Pack 1 for Microsoft SharePoint Server 2013](#) installed on the computer.

July 11, 2017, update for Project Server 2013 (KB3213577)

This update fixes the following issues:

- Sporadically, master or sub projects become usual projects.
- A user cannot edit summary tasks lock field in the Project Center while using Project Web App.

Description of the security update for SharePoint Server 2016: July 11, 2017

This security update contains improvements for the following nonsecurity issues:

- Improve word breaking for Thai.

This security update contains fixes for the following nonsecurity issues:

- The administrative backup and restore of the Category and Group Settings don't work.

- After you upgrade a site from SharePoint Server 2013 to SharePoint Server 2016 (such as by using the mount-spcntentdatabase cmdlet), versioning is enabled for all document libraries even if they did not have this feature previously enabled.
- After you use the SharePoint Active Directory import option (AD import) for a User Profile service application, the Assistant property's value is incorrectly set to the Manager property's value.

This security update contains fixes for the following nonsecurity issues for Project Server 2016:

- Reliability and functionality issues when a SharePoint Server 2013 content farm is consuming a UPA service application from a SharePoint Server 2016 farm.
- A user cannot edit summary tasks lock field in the Project Center while using Project Web App.
- You can't edit items in quick edit mode in a document library that has more than two pages of files when the **Edit** function (the link to edit items) is enabled. This issue occurs after you move to a different page of items.
- Sub projects may become normal projects sporadically in Project 2016.

This update fixes the following issues:

- When you export eDiscovery search results, preserved attachments aren't exported.
- You don't correctly escape quotation marks when a list item is exported from the Preservation Hold list.
