Description of the security update for SharePoint Enterprise Server 2016: April 12, 2022 (KB5002183)

Improvements and fixes

This security update contains a fix for the following nonsecurity issue in SharePoint Server 2016:

- Fixes an issue in which cascading style sheets (CSS) files are changed when you select **Discard check out**.

This security update also contains a fix for the following nonsecurity issue in Project Server:

- Fixes an issue in which percentage information is missing from the **Current Progress** column after you select a timesheet on the **Import Timesheet** page.

Description of the security update for SharePoint Server 2019: April 12, 2022 (KB5002180)

Improvements and fixes

This security update contains improvements and fixes for the following nonsecurity issues in SharePoint Server 2019:

- Fixes an issue in which a new list item cannot be created in the modern user experience (UX) page if the list with lookup columns is pointing to very large lists that hits the **MaxJSONLength** limit.
- Fixes an issue in which you cannot copy and paste values into the **Person or Group** column by using **Quick Edit** in a custom list if the account has same first and last name values as other accounts have.

- Fixes an issue in which you cannot restore a subsite by using System Center Data Protection Manager (DPM).
- Fixes an issue in which you cannot see the files that are accessed recently under the **Recent** tab in OneDrive. This issue occurs because the search API does not work when the HTTP-Origin header is not null.
- Fixes an issue in which an "Event ID b0mtg" occurs when you upload documents. This issue spams Unified Logging System (ULS) with unexpected errors.
- Fixes an issue in which users who do not have the "View Items" permission can't see the left navigation pane on modern sites that have the publishing features enabled.

This security update also contains fixes for the following nonsecurity issues in SharePoint Server 2019. To fix these issues completely, you have to install [KB 5002164](#) together with this update.

- Fixes an issue in which "(!) Required info" is shown instead of metadata in modern list views for document libraries that have required managed metadata fields.
- Fixes an issue in which SharePoint Server stops opening links in a new tab with modern view in the **Site Contents** page.
- Fixes an issue in which Share Panel doesn't have valid values in the communication site.
- Fixes an issue in which the **Text and table formatting** panel doesn't have an accessible name in the communication site.
- Fixes an issue in which some ARIA attributes don't have valid values on the **Site Contents** page.
- Fixes an issue in which Narrator doesn't announce the deleted character in the search box.
- Fixes an issue in which the **Add column** option is missing in the column header.
- Fixes an issue in which some icons cannot be shown in a modern list.
- Fixes an issue in which the Hero web part picture stretches incorrectly.
- Fixes an issue in which Narrator users are not informed of the news list.

This security update fixes the following nonsecurity issues in Project Server 2019:

- Fixes an issue in which the language of the values in flag-type custom fields within an online analytical processing (OLAP) cube do not match the Project Server language. For example, the flag values appear as "True" or "False" in English, and they are "Vero" or "Falso" in Italian, but the values are always displayed in the English form.
- Fixes the **DatabaseUndefinedError** and **System.Data.SqlClient.SqlException (0x80131904): There is already an object named 'pk_It_uids' in the database** errors that occur when you query lookup tables by using the SharePoint client-side object model (CSOM).
