Description of the security update for SharePoint Server 2019: August 13, 2019

This security update contains improvements and fixes for the following nonsecurity issues:

- Improved SharePoint search compatibility with PDF files.
- Fix: The search crawler fails if the crawl proxy exclusion list starts with an asterisk (*) wildcard character. This causes content that is accessed through proxy servers to be non-searchable in the farm.
- Fix: When the Schedule Variance Percentage (SVP) earned value field becomes very large, an overflow condition occurs and prevents PWA project views from loading.
- Fix: When you click the **Export to Excel** button to export data on pages such as from the Project Center, you receive the following error message:
