- Fixes an issue in which extremely long links inside documents corrupt when you upgrade a content database from SharePoint Server 2013 or SharePoint Server 2016 to SharePoint Server 2019.

This security update also contains a fix for the following nonsecurity issue in Project Server:

- Fixes an issue in which the **Export to Excel** button doesn't work on Project Web App pages. Instead of seeing the grid data appear in Excel, you receive the following error message:

Sorry, something went wrong. An unexpected error has occurred.
