This update fixes an issue in which the document URL in the callout ellipse in a document library is missing the DocID query string parameter if the Document ID feature is enabled.

#### Improvements and fixes

This security update contains fixes for the following nonsecurity issues in SharePoint Server 2019:

- Removes the **Document and List Static Data Fixed SampleJob** timer job from SharePoint Server. This timer job is intended for SharePoint Online use only. Therefore, it should not be included in SharePoint Server.

**Note:** To fix this issue, you have to install [KB 4493231](#) together with this update.

- Fixes an issue in which the Document Information Panel (DIP) fields are blank for a document in a folder that has diacritics or umlaut characters in its name.
- Fixes an issue in which items are duplicated in Quick Edit mode when you copy more than 100 items from Excel into a list in modern UI.
- Some application pools can't be restarted after you run [Install-SPSolution](#). After you install this update, all application pools can be restarted successfully.

- Fixes an issue in which filtering out list items by using the **Empty** option on the **Date** column in a Task list doesn't work.
- Fixes an issue in which a registration email isn't sent if the alert is registered through the client-side object model (CSOM).
- Fixes an issue in which the numerical designations of weeks in DatePicker are incorrect for many European locales.

This security update also contains fixes for the following nonsecurity issues in Project Server 2019:

- The projects for which the project summary task is locked are shown in the list of projects on the **Add Task** page. This page is accessed from the Task and Timesheet views by using the **Add Yourself to a Task** option.
- The SharePoint Products Configuration Wizard doesn't finish if the SQL Server collation is Turkish\_CI\_AS. Additionally, the PSCDiagnostics log shows an error message that resembles the following:

```
"ERR Failed to upgrade SharePoint Products.  
An exception of type System.Data.SqlClient.SqlException was thrown.  
Additional exception information: Must declare the scalar variable  
"@newViewUID".  
System.Data.SqlClient.SqlException (0x80131904)"
```
