## March 8, 2022, update for SharePoint Server 2019 (KB5002163)

Improvements and fixes

This update contains the following fixes in SharePoint Server 2019:

- Fixes an issue in which the Distributed Cache service crashes in SharePoint Server 2019.
- Fixes an issue in which the user logon name does not synchronize with Active Directory (AD) when it is a Windows legacy account. In addition, after you install this update, the user logon name will synchronize with AD when you change the logon name of a disabled user and re-enable it.
- Fixes an issue in which the group header is shown incorrectly when you select **Group by Date** on the **Date** column in a document library modern view.
