- Fixes an issue in which you can't publish new forms to sites with the **CMSPUBLISHING** template type.

Description of the security update for SharePoint Server 2019: May 10, 2022 (KB5002207)

Improvements and fixes

This security update contains improvements and fixes for the following nonsecurity issues in SharePoint Server 2019:

- Fixes an issue in which you can't publish new forms to sites with the **CMSPUBLISHING** template type.
- Fixes an issue in which multiline deletion doesn't work as expected when you edit a list in grid view.
- Fixes an issue in which you might receive the "404 not found" error when the SAML authentication expiration occurs before you upload a document to a document library.
- Fixes an issue in which extremely long links inside documents corrupt when you upgrade a content database from SharePoint Server 2013 or SharePoint Server 2016 to SharePoint Server 2019.
