This security update contains fixes and improvements for the following nonsecurity issues in SharePoint Server 2019:

- Adds a Timer job to detect and repair content database inconsistencies in the SharePoint Server configuration.
- Fixes an issue in which running PSConfig.exe consumes a lot of memory if several web applications are running in your farm.

- Fixes an issue in which you receive a "RequestNotSupported" Colbalt error when replacing a duplicate file from a SharePoint Server 2010 content database in the modern UI.
- Fixes an issue in which you can't rate a SharePoint list item when the users who rated the item are removed from the user information list.
- Fixes an issue in which the **Configure Hybrid Features** button in the Farm Configuration Wizard starts the Hybrid Configuration Wizard the first time that you select it, but doesn't work for subsequent selections until the page is refreshed.
- Fixes an issue in which a document can't open in the client application if you copy the link of the document and access the link in Microsoft Edge. This issue occurs even if the document library is set to OpenInClient.
- Fixes an issue in which selecting the **Name (linked to document)** column doesn't open the document in the client application in classic view. This issue occurs even if the document library is set to OpenInClient.
- Fixes an issue in which the client application can't be started to open a non-browser-enabled InfoPath form in modern browsers. Additionally, you receive the following error message:
"This form cannot be opened in a Web browser. To open this form, use Microsoft InfoPath."
- Fixes an issue in which you can't migrate from classic-mode to claims-based authentication.
- Fixes an issue in which Document Sets that contain non-ASCII characters (for example, Spanish or Chinese) might not be crawled successfully.
- Fixes an issue in which SharePoint Designer doesn't work for non-English sites.
